



Travel Appointment with the Travel Nurse

To schedule, choose one option, A-D:

- A.** If traveling to Spain and/or Italy, please call Campus Health Support Services at (520) 621-9202 to schedule a “20-Minute Group Zoom Travel Appointment.” There are Group Zoom Appointments occurring multiple times a week throughout the semester.
- B.** If traveling to Europe, New Zealand, Iceland, Greenland, or Canada please schedule a “20-Minute, Individual, Zoom Travel Appointment.” No vaccines are required for these travel destinations, yet the latest COVID-19 vaccine, the Flu vaccine, and an updated Tetanus vaccine are important to consider prior to international travel. Schedule a separate immunization appointment through PatientLink to receive a vaccine at Campus Health.
- C.** If traveling to all other countries, please call Campus Health Support Services at (520) 621-9202 to schedule a “40-Minute, In-Person, Travel Appointment.” Schedule this appointment at least **4-6 weeks in advance** to receive the appropriate recommended vaccines (some vaccines have multiple doses) for specific countries.
- D.** If traveling to 4 or more countries, please call Campus Health Support Services at (520) 621-9202 to schedule a “60-Minute, In-Person, Travel Appointment.” Schedule this appointment at least **4-6 weeks in advance** so that you may receive appropriate recommended vaccines (some vaccines have multiple doses) for specific countries.



Statement of Good Health

For the completion of the “**Statement of Good Health**” by a Medical Provider for a Visa Application, call (520) 621-9202 to schedule an appointment with a Medical Provider. Schedule a “Statement of Good Health Medical Provider Appointment” **6-8 weeks prior to the consulate deadline**. A separate “Travel Appointment” must **also** be scheduled to suffice requirements for Study Abroad Travel Programs. See options **A** through **D** to schedule the Travel Appointment.

Please note:

- The Travel Nurse and the Medical Provider Appointments are **2 separate appointments** in different departments at Campus Health.
- Upload any documents required for travel to your patient portal to allow Campus Health staff to review documents and determine how to best meet travel needs prior to consulate deadline dates. **Travel documents to enter a country may require bloodwork, a chest x-ray, and/or TB screening which may require an additional appointment(s).**
