Key Insights

- Helped them **develop** **skills** that they will use in their **personal life**

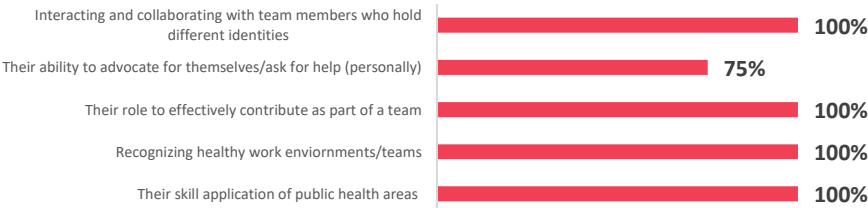
