
GRANT FUNDS

- August 2010: Moved from state/tuition partial funding to Health & Recreation Fee

- August 2016: Opened Counseling & Psych Services (CAPS) Satellite Clinic in Yuma Hall
- 2016-Present: Travel/Immunization Clinic and CAPS utilization is at an all-time high
