HIGHLIGHTS



- **July 2004:** CHS begins using Electronic Health Records
- **August 2010:** Moved from state/tuition partial funding to Health & Recreation Fee
- **April 2016:** Implemented patient preferred name
- **August 2016:** Opened Counseling & Psych Services (CAPS) Satellite Clinic in Yuma Hall
- **2016-Present:** Travel/Immunization Clinic and CAPS utilization is at an all-time high
- **2018:** Celebrating 100 years of quality health care and service to the UA
